Mission Statement

The Fountain Clinic seeks to provide healthcare for those who have inadequate or no health insurance.

Who Do We Help?

The Fountain Clinic helps those whose yearly income is less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, who do not qualify for other programs such as Medicaid/Medicare, and who cannot afford medical insurance.

When Are We Open?

The Fountain Clinic is open Monday-Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM. Occasionally, the Clinic closes for lunch and/or meetings, so patients should always phone (269) 781-0952 before coming.

Physician Clinics, staffed by volunteer physicians and physician assistants, are held 2-4 days a week. In most cases, Physician Clinics are held on a first come, first serve basis, which can result in a long waiting time.

A Registered Nurse is on site 5 days a week.

All new patients must bring proof of income (pay stub, last year's income tax return, etc.). There is no charge, but donations are requested.

What Services Do We Provide?

-Physician & physician assistant clinics are provided.

-Labs & x-rays ordered by the Clinic's volunteer physician for Fountain Clinic patients are mainly covered by a grant from *Oaklawn Hospital*.

-Prescription assistance & dental assistance is provided to senior citizens 60 and older who meet *Calhoun County Senior Millage* guidelines

-People needing help with prescriptions may be eligible for assistance through pharmaceutical companies' programs. We assists anyone, whether or not they are Fountain Clinic patients, in enrolling in these programs.

-The Fountain Clinic **DOES NOT COVER HOSPITAL CHARGES**, including emergency room visits.

-The Fountain Clinic **is not a pharmacy**. Prescriptions are only provided to Fountain Clinic patients or through the programs mentioned above. **Controlled substances are not prescribed or dispensed.**

-Optical referrals are available for anyone in the Marshall area or anyone with a letter from their local Lion's Club.
