Dental Program

Besides offering primary medical care to the uninsured, the Fountain Clinic also offers dental services to qualified uninsured. The clinic has a dental operatory complete with x-ray equipment and autoclave. In January dental hygienist Maria Miller joined us. Maria does cleanings, screenings, dental x-rays and dental education. The Clinic collaborates with the Family

Health Center and the Nursing Clinic now called Calhoun Health Care Connections. This collaboration is called the Calhoun Dental Access Initiative. The Calhoun Dental Initiative is a pay it forward dental program which treats patients who have dental pain. The program currently has 35 volunteer dentists and 2 hygienists. The patients pay

forward by doing volunteer work for nonprofits. Dr. Charles Palumbo, one of our volunteer dentists, oversees the hygienists. For more information about this program, please call the Clinic or 969-6494.
